MISSION STATEMENT

- ✓ Water resources and management.
- ✓ Employment, with sustainable and fair pay, conditions and salary packages.
- ✓ The re-establishment of a competitive "Bank of Australia" and Government insurance office.

Policy preamble

It's been said by our protractors that One Nation policy would take us back to the bad old days of the 50's. Really! There's a lot to be said about the 50's and we are not trying to put Australia in a time warp. It was a time that gave us ample employment and Australia's achievement was to give it amongst the highest living standards in the world. This was achieved through patriotic government, sound economic management and well-conceived legislation. This was all achievable because of a system that we had inherited, and today, instead of trying to destroy that system out of existence, we should be embracing and improving it.

1. The rights of the Family.

A) The Family. **B)** Fatherhood. **C)** Motherhood. Because of progressive and intrusive legislation, the Authority of the Parent is continually being eroded, the family unit itself broken down. We wish to strengthen and advocate traditional family values and uphold the institution of the family as essential to the well being of individuals and society as a whole. It is also our intention to give separated/divorced fathers the ability to re-establish their lives and be capable of affording to live. Child support will be made sustainable and the CSA persecution attitude dispensed with. Father's gaining more time with their children.

2. Apprenticeships.

One Nation supports the operation of an effective system of apprenticeships. We would encourage cooperation between governments at state and federal level, in order that employers can be subsidised to take on apprentices. We propose a subsidy of 75% in the first year, 50% the second and 25% the third. As a nation we have an obvious need to assist our young to obtain vocational skills with public funds for the national good.

3. Education.

One Nation is committed to the fundamental level of education that encompasses at the very least, writing, reading, spoken skills of communication and expression, combined with essential mathematics to ensure successful participation in society. The reintroduction of the concept of responsibility and the adoption of a respectful attitude towards each other and others, in particular parents, teachers and the elderly.

4. Health.

A Nationally funded public health system that has the capacity in Facility, Plant and Staff to cope with a National State of Emergency. Hospitals would also be returned to the control of the "Public Hospital Board". This will restore control to the local community. One Nation supports the re-introduction of funding for community care programs such as meals on wheels, home maintenance, community transport and home help services, which are essential for the elderly and disabled.

5. Public utilities and Privatisation.

One Nation recognises that our public utilities are essential commodities that should be owned by all Australians and protected from privatisation at all costs. Therefore the reversal of private ownership of all-essential public services and utilities ie. water, electricity, communications, the Commonwealth Bank and Insurance.

6. Taxation.

We wish to abolish the GST and its replacement with a tax that is not crippling of the common people. The Australian Tax Office ATO will also be overhauled. One Nation perceives Payroll Tax as a tax on employment and is a major cost to employers. It and other inequitable taxes such as land tax will be reassessed with a view to abolition.

7. Citizens Initiated Referendum.

One Nation supports direct democratic involvement of the Australian people, (**C. I. R.**) Simply, we have faith in the good sense and fair-minded attitude of Australians. It gives back to the people the opportunity to directly address the issues of real concern, all too often left unaddressed under the current system of election and government. It grants the people the right and ability to initiate legislation directly, without hindering the Westminster system of representative government. It provides the facility for Australians to raise their concerns for debate and public decision.

8. The Governor General.

We propose the Governor General be re-empowered, proclaimed head of state, while retaining and re-implementing "The Commonwealth of Australia" or "The Federation of Australia" and its' mechanics, rights and responsibilities. All Commonwealth formalities, tradition and ties, would continue. The GG would be popularly elected with strict criteria, rules and guidelines. This person would watch over our politicians as an umpire would watch over a game or sport. SHE or HE would also preside over their income.

9. The intention of Science.

To advance Australia's scientific knowledge, influence in Space and associated entities, alternative energy sources, Funding for Research and Educational institutes.

10. Public works and Ecological.

We shall endeavour to undertake public works wherever there is great need, such as river levy banks and other water and flood mitigation works. The re-channelling and capturing of otherwise lost excessive water. A return to sane and proven ecological management of land and resources. Conservation V's Preservation. (Refer to "Environment" Paper).

11. Pension and Veteran.

Our assurance of the continuation of all categories of pension's rights and benefits. Note: The softening up on the criteria (those once afforded) to Home Care allowance: The Full recognition, thus honouring, all Australian War and Conflict personnel: Also the maintenance / reclamation / repatriation of their remains, (where neglect and or vandalism have defaced and dishonoured their resting-place).

12. GATS and WTO.

One Nation has stood fast and will continue to oppose any treaty that is detrimental to Australia, its people, industries and way of life.
